

# OHSAS 18001 Occupational Health and Safety Management System

OHSAS 18001 is an internationally recognised Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) management standard that enables an organisation to control its OHS risks and improve performance.

This standard provides a framework for the effective management of OHS including the identification of all hazards, the assessment of the risks and the deployment of appropriate control measures. The standard also dictates that organisations demonstrate compliance with both existing and emerging relevant OHS legislation.

CCEA embraces the doctrines of the standard to ensure that OHS is fully recognised by all staff as essential to the efficient running of the organisation. CCEA acknowledges the importance of OHS and has been successfully accredited to OHSAS 18001 since June 2007. Re-accreditation of the standard is subject to twice yearly assessment visits.

Since 2008 CCEA has been reaccredited to the standard with no non-compliances at each of the seven six-monthly assessments.
