Unit 2 Mock Examinations – January 2010

CCEA are running mock examinations during January. CCEA recommend that all centres take part in the mocks to give practice to candidates using the examination system and also to technicians during setup. If your centre has never run the examination before then the mock is a requirement before your centre undertakes the live examination, to ensure that all systems will run smoothly on the day.

CCEA will not be marking any scripts, however candidate scripts will be returned to the teacher a few days after the examination along with mark schemes.

Mock Registration Process

To enter for the mock examinations teachers must register their candidates online via a website: <http://www.movingimagearts.org.uk/register/>. Before registering please have both the teacher and technician's name, email address and also your centre number to hand.

The closing date for registrations is Tuesday 12 January 2010.

Once registered, a page will display your candidates' logins which you should make a note of. These numbers are NOT your pupils' usual candidate numbers but are instead numbers generated exclusively for use in the mock exam. These will be displayed on the web page after registration and will also be emailed to the teacher.

You must then download the *Step by Step Guide* which explains how to run the examination. The examination files must be downloaded by the technician the day before the examination to allow for testing time. The password for use on the day will be sent by email the week before the examination to the teacher.

NB: The two set text films for the A2 mock examination will be *The Cabinet of Doctor Caligari* (1920 Director: Robert Wiene) and *The King's Wake* (1999 Director: John McCloskey). *The Cabinet of Doctor Caligari* is on general release and can also be viewed at a number of sites on the internet. Please contact CCEA if you are unable to source a copy of *The King's Wake*, which was produced by the Nerve Centre in 1999 (www.nerve-centre.org.uk).
