



## GCSE Uniform Mark Tables

### Definition of Grades

The results of GCSE Science Double Award are reported on an 8-point scale of grades: A\*A\*, AA, BB, CC, DD, EE, FF and GG. Candidates who do not reach the minimum standard (Grade GG) will be ungraded (U) and the result will not be certified.

### Conversion of uniform marks to grades

The tables below show the relationship between notional grades and uniform marks (UM) at unit/module level and between grades and total uniform marks at subject level for Modular specifications.
