Revised Specifications

In recent months Occupational Studies has undergone a Regulatory Review in all occupational areas. Some of the occupational area units have had little or no changes, however, some units have gone through significant changes and teachers/tutors need to acquaint themselves with the changed requirements.

The revised units will be available for teaching from January 2008 for assessment in summer 2008, these can be downloaded from the CCEA website at www.ccea.org.uk in September 2007. Some 'Pilot' units will no longer be available for teaching, these units will have final entry for teaching from September 2007 for last assessment in January 2008.
